#### SAFEGUARING AWARENESS LEVEL 1 RQF

FAA LEVEL 1 AWARD IN AWARENESS OF SAFEGUARDING (RQF)

This qualification is suitable for all persons and will provide an understanding of safeguarding which can be used in a workplace, activity group or any instance where a person comes into contact with children or adults at risk. The qualification provides learners with the knowledge to identify a safeguarding concern, listen and appropriately record a disclosure, and report to the appropriate person

**Entry requirements** The qualification is available to learners aged 14 or over. It is recommended that learners should hold a minimum of Level 1 in literacy or equivalent to undertake this qualification. It may be possible to allocate a reasonable adjustment to a learner who has a disability, medical condition or learning need; learners should contact their training provider to discuss.


<u>Qualification delivery</u> The qualification has 4 assigned guided learning hours (GLH). The minimum classroom contact time of 4 hours should be delivered over a minimum of half a day. The course can be spread over a maximum of 2 weeks, ensuring that each session is a minimum of two hours. The class ratio for this qualification is a maximum of 16 learners to 1 Trainer/Assessor.

<u>Certification</u> The qualification does not have an expiry date but refresher training and keeping up to date with changes to policies, procedures and new legislation through ongoing CPD is vital.

## SAFEGUARING LEVEL 3 ROF

FAA LEVEL 1 AWARD IN AWARENESS OF SAFEGUARDING (RQF)

The qualification is designed for learners who have contact with children, young people or vulnerable adults in their working environment including voluntary work. It promotes awareness and sensitivity to safeguarding enabling learners to be able to identify issues and emphasises the responsibility to ensure that concerns are reported and acted on appropriately.

**Entry requirements** The qualification is available to learners aged 18 or over. It is recommended that learners should hold a minimum of Level 1 in literacy or equivalent to undertake this qualification. It may be possible to allocate a reasonable adjustment to a learner who has a disability, medical condition or learning need; learners should contact their training provider to discuss

<u>Qualification delivery</u> The qualification has 7 assigned guided learning hours (GLH). The minimum classroom contact time of 7 hours must be delivered over a minimum of 1 day. The course can be spread over a maximum of 3 weeks, ensuring that each session is a minimum of two hours. The class ratio for this qualification is a maximum of 12 learners to 1 Trainer/Assessor


